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## Virginia Plans Mandatory COVID-19 Vaccinations For All Residents

*As Friday’s hospitalization numbers across the Sun Belt appear to confirm CDC head Dr. Robert Redfield’s assertion that the American COVID-19 outbreak has peaked and is starting to fade, the State of Virginia is setting a new precedent by seriously discussing forcing Virginians to be vaccinated with whatever rushed-to-market candidate the FDA approves first.*

*During an interview that aired on Friday, the state’s health commissioner said he planned to invoke state law to make vaccinations mandatory – once a western product is available, presumably.*

State Health Commissioner Dr. Norman Oliver told 8News on Friday that he plans to mandate coronavirus vaccinations for Virginians once one is made available to the public.

Virginia state law gives the Commissioner of Health the authority to mandate immediate immunizations during a public health crisis if a vaccine is available. Health officials say an immunization could be released as early as 2021.

Dr. Oliver says that, as long as he is still the Health Commissioner, he intends to mandate the coronavirus vaccine.

***“It is killing people now, we don’t have a treatment for it and if we develop a vaccine that can prevent it from spreading in the community we will save hundreds and hundreds of lives,”*** Oliver said.

Pro-medical-choice activists in the state argue that the issue is a matter of medical choice, and that the hasty “expedited” approval process being implemented by the FDA is grounds for concern. State health authorities insist, meanwhile, that they would never mandate a vaccine that hadn’t already proven to be safe.

Virginia Freedom Keepers Director of Communications Kathleen Medaries, a mother of three from Chesterfield, says this is a matter of medical choice. This is not a Republican or Democrat issue. It’s not a pro-vaccine or anti-vaccine issue,” Medaries said. ***“For me, it’s an issue of being able to assess each vaccine for myself and my family one at a time.”***

***“He shouldn’t be the one person to make a decision for all of Virginians,”*** Medaries responded.

The state’s top medical official is opposed to a bill that has been put forth in the state assembly that would create more exemptions to the mandatory vaccination power, allowing exemptions on religious and other grounds.

Oliver believes that COVID-19 is a public health emergency that should take precedent over everything else, and that vaccine-assisted herd immunity is the state’s best and only real defense.

The decision comes after Massachusetts said it would make the flu vaccine mandatory this year as part of a campaign to protect the state’s medical system. We suspect Virginia and Massachusetts won’t be the only states to discuss mandatory COVID and/or flu vaccination in the coming weeks, as the school year begins.

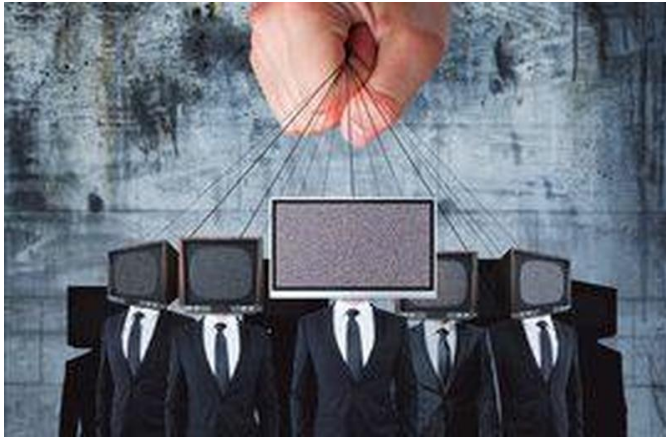
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## **CDC Admits COVID-19 Antibody Tests Are Wrong Half The Time & Virus Isn’t That Deadly**

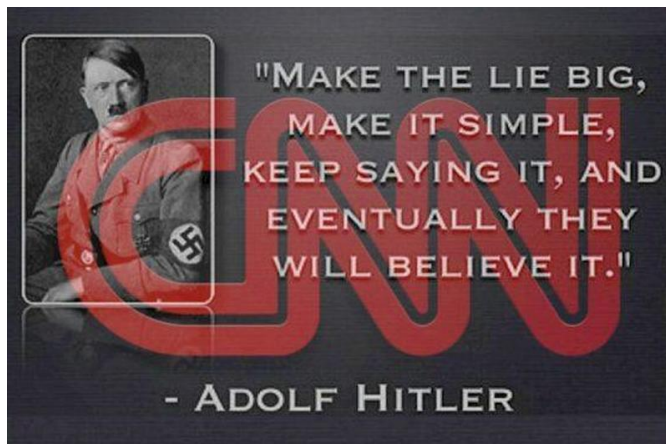

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## **Bill Prohibiting the Governor from Using Law Enforcement to Enforce Unconstitutional Executive Orders Advances in Tennessee House**

A bill that would prohibit a governor of Tennessee from using law enforcement to enforce executive orders that violate constitutional rights advanced in the House State Committee Wednesday.

While the bill will serve to address elements of fascism that could be used in conjunction with executive orders such as those issued for the sake of containing the spread of COVID-19, the eloquent and passionate presentation of the bill by its sponsor Bud Hulsey (R-Kingsport) also serves as a straightforward explanation of what happened over the past two months as well as a lesson in constitutional principles.

Prior to the legislature's adjournment on March 19 until June, Hulsey's [HB2291](#) would have amended a portion of the Tennessee Code dealing with the investigations of police officers.

Returning to committee meetings the week of May 25 in preparation for session the week of June 1, Hulsey offered a different amendment to deal with the more contemporary issues related to the handling of COVID-19.

Before explaining the specifics of the amendment that makes the bill, Hulsey said he would have to preface it with some remarks about his perspective on what we've been through the last two and a half months in the state.

"I think we have put our Governor in a terrible, terrible, terrible position because the legislature who defined these rails," said Hulsey as he demonstrated the rails with both his hands, "and set up the system for the governor to operate in."

Hulsey's assessment of that system, "I think we've done him wrong."

Using a familiar reference to create a picture for the committee, Hulsey told the members, "We've said to the governor, 'We in the legislative branch, governor, this is what you're going to do and this is how you do it. All you've got to do is say the word emergency three times and click your heels together and we here in the legislature are going to take a magic wand and we're going to wave it over your head and we're going to endow you with the power to make law.'"

Making matters worse, Hulsey said the legislature has also essentially said to the governor, "And, if you need the judicial branch to back you up, that's okay, we don't mind."

Hulsey summarized those scenarios, “Now you’ve got the two branches of government that’s not supposed to be making law, making law.”

Further elaborating, Hulsey went on to offer a description of events in his straightforward way.

*Then we said to the governor, ‘This is what we want you to do next.*

*We want you to segregate all the people and the businesses in this state into two piles.*

*One pile we’ll call useful people with useful businesses the other pile are for useless people and useless businesses.*

*Now, dear Lord, don’t call it that, governor. Use a benign word like essential and non-essential.*

*And, then when you get them separated governor, this is what you what you need to do next.*

*You need to ensure that the useful people with useful businesses maintain most of their constitutional protections. So they can go about the way they need to go and do what they want to do and go to work and make a living.*

*If they have a useful business that’s big enough, you can peacefully assemble a hundred, two hundred, three hundred people in there at one time. It’s no problem.*

*But, the useless folks with the useless business, we want you to suspend their constitutional protection and that way you can say to them, you shut your door, you go to the house and you stay there until we tell you [that] you can come out.*

*And the only time we’re going to tell you to come out is if you want to go do business and spend your money at a useful business. The rest of the time, you stay at the house.’*

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About those useless people without a useful job and needed assistance, Hulsey said, “Draw your check.”

In light of the much-publicized delays the state Department of Labor has had in responding to the significantly increased demand for relief, Hulsey added, “Oh, that check thing, it may be two or three months. The computer system is really backed up. Suck it up. It’s for your own good.”

For the useful folks and useful businesses, Hulsey says their constitutional protections were retained so “We can’t harass them with the police.”

On the other hand, if the useless business and useless people get out of line – using the example of 11 showing up at a prayer meeting on a Wednesday night – the police come to the door and say, “You conform and do what you’re told, or you’ll go to jail for 11 months and 29 days.”

He then asked, rhetorically, “How the heck did we get here?”

In a teaching moment as a retired law enforcement officer, Hulsey then said to his fellow House State Committee members while wagging his finger, “Now, listen, any time you use police power to enforce an executive fiat or decree, that is a form of fascism that this constitution does not recognize and it does not tolerate.”

After a brief but dramatic pause, Hulsey explained that his amendment “doesn’t fix all this mess that we created for the governor,” but admitted that it does need to be fixed so that the governor is never put in “that mess” again.

What the amendment does do, advised Hulsey, “It strips out the fascism out of the three most egregious constitutional areas.”

Very simply, the bill states, “The governor or the chief executive officer of a local government shall not require a law enforcement agency or an officer thereof to enforce a provision of an executive order: (1) Requiring a private business entity to close; (2) Restricting the freedom to assemble peaceably; or (3) Restricting the freedom to travel.”

Hulsey explained the bill this way: “It says you cannot use law enforcement to enforce an edict out of the executive branch that denies people the ability to assemble peaceably, that gives them the right to go to work and earn a living and allows them to move around this state freely without the government infringing on them.”

When Nashville Democrat Representative Harold Love, Jr. questioned Hulsey as to who would enforce executive orders, the bill sponsor responded, “There’s four hurdles you have to get over if you say we have to suspend the constitution because we have a virus.”

Representative Hulsey went on to explain,

*Here’s the first one. You can’t tell Tennessee people, look folks the United States Constitution, the State of Tennessee’s Constitution is the law of the land ... well kind of. Until you have a virus and somebody dies. You can’t say that.*

*Here’s the second huge hurdle that you need to get over and that says I don’t think it’s constitutionally legal for the legislative branch in the state of Tennessee to cede to the governor the power to make law. I don’t think we have a right constitutionally to do it. Clarence Thomas has been arguing that for years.*

*The third big huge hurdle is what all the framers said and they believe. If you go read what they said, my, the men who signed the declaration did not say we pledge our lives, our fortunes and our sacred honor ... for public health. They never said that. They said for liberty. Patrick Henry didn’t jump up and say give me health or give me death. The Revolutionary War wasn’t fought over King George depriving us of health and safety. Everything in that whole concept is all bound up in liberty and freedom. So you have to get over that hurdle.*

*And, I’m getting to your question, but I have to preface it with this.*

*The fourth hurdle that you’ve got to get over is if you say we’ve got to suspend the constitution but we have a virus and people die. Then, you have to say the greatest American value, the greatest American virtue is health and safety. That’s not what the constitution says. It says that the greatest American value is what it’s always been, and that’s liberty and freedom.*

To more directly answer Love’s question, Hulsey said that Tennessee people are not stupid and that if they were told that they could die from the virus and there were certain things they should do if they don’t want to die, they will do it.

“I don’t think you have to violate the constitution and suspend constitutional principles to get Tennesseans to practice safe health and avoid a virus.”

Representatives Bill Beck and Jason Powell, also Nashville Democrats, expressed concerns about the inability of the governor to issue executive orders and use police powers to limit the movement of Tennesseans for things like curfews.

Nashville/Davidson County is one of six that have their own health department and operated under different executive orders than that of the other 89 in the state. Nashville's restrictions were greater than the rest of the state and also started the reopening process later.

While there was a back-and-forth dialogue between the Nashville representatives and Hulseby about these issues, he mainly maintained his position that police cannot be used relative to enforcement of the three constitutional issues.

Representative Johnny Shaw (D-Bolivar) offered a perspective about the religious community, because of the example of a Wednesday night prayer service. He made the point that church is totally separate and different from government, and that people don't "go to church," because church is within an individual. Rather, pointed out Shaw, people go to a house of worship.

A theology major and minister, Shaw made it clear that his congregation didn't stay home because of anything the governor said or what the legislative body did, but because 65 percent of the congregation have underlying issues.

He concluded, "They have nothing whatsoever to do with the church."

Majority Assistant Floor Leader Chris Todd (R-Madison County) applauded Hulseby for the bill and the clarity with which he brought it. He said he had the same concern that too much had been put on the shoulders of the governor that should have been on the shoulders of the legislature.

Todd said that he doesn't believe it's in the constitution that the governor bear this alone and that it's not on law enforcement to start interpreting what the constitution says versus the laws that are on the books.

Saying he wouldn't be nearly as eloquent, Representative Justin Lafferty (R-Knoxville) told Hulseby he would "give it a ride" as he applauded what the bill sponsor is working toward.

"Our country was founded on these principles of freedom and liberty. There are dangers inherent in freedom and liberty. We decided very long ago to make that trade. We will take our chances, as long as we can live our lives and be free and control our own destiny our own futures."

Lafferty says that things have expanded beyond the current issue.

"It's becoming a bigger issue in our society as a whole as we continue to cede more and more power to more and more agencies, more and more groups, more and more governmental "quasi-governmental" organizations."

After expressing appreciation for Hulseby setting the stage for him to make his comments,

Lafferty reflected, "Perhaps in a hundred years, we might look back and see that this is a question of our age that we had to address."

On a voice vote, HB2291 advanced to the House Calendar & Rules Committee to be scheduled for a floor vote.

The companion Senate bill, SB2368 is sponsored by Senator Mark Pody (R-Lebanon) and has been placed on the calendar of the Senate Judiciary Committee for Tuesday, June 2 at 3:00 p.m. However, SB2368 appears on Calendar 2 of the Senate Judiciary Committee, as opposed to the calendar for "COVID-19, Time Sensitive or Budget Related" bills.

One of the greatest economic booms in our country's history has been brought to its knees by a virus. Over 80,000 souls have been lost to this pandemic, and our country is slowly collapsing. The number of businesses lost to this virus is said to be about 100,000 that will never come back—one hundred thousand livelihoods and families that will no longer grace our towns and cities across this country. The economic downturn has been devastating, and there are many of our fellow citizens that will never recover.

Dr. Anthony Fauci is tasked with leading us through this as the resident "expert" that has all of America shut down. It was his advice to President Trump that has locked down our country. 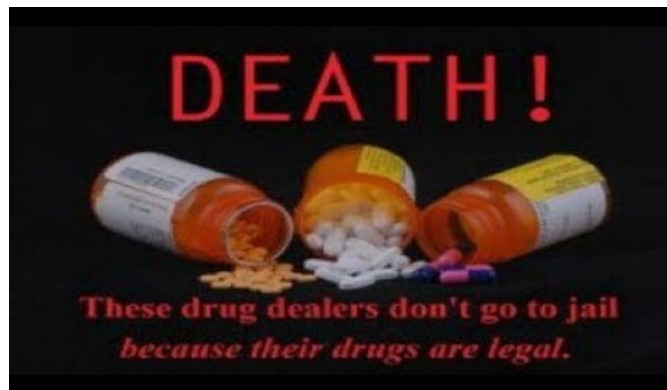
Dr. Fauci persuaded President Trump to "lockdown" the entire U.S. economy based on a false Imperial College model-based on the work of Dr. Neil Ferguson. The Imperial College model has since been deemed to be a model "completely unusable for scientific purposes." If the model was so flawed, why did Dr. Fauci not look closer into the results and question the facts as they were presented? It has been agreed to by many, including software engineer Sue Denim, that the Ferguson model "is garbage and can not be scientifically replicated." The results- a destroyed economy and over 30 million Americans out of work and on the edge of generational poverty is the result of Dr. Fauci not understanding the impact of statements based on failure.

Another study that Dr. Fauci showed to the President as factual was the study from the University of Washington IHME, another project funded by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. Once again, Fauci showed a preference for fault models and the meaningless havoc they would cause.

As the proclaimed "infectious disease specialist," Fauci has had many failures of this Chinese virus. On January 21 of this year, Fauci proclaimed the coronavirus was not a major threat and was something the American people should worry about. On February 29, Fauci told NBC Today that there is no need to change anything you are doing on a day to day basis. All these statements were based on World Health Organization statements, which Dr. Fauci parroted to the American People. Perhaps it is informative that Fauci had signed a memo of understanding with the WHO in 2018, stipulating that Fauci would rely on the WHO for information about China outbreaks.

Fauci's failures go back to the HIV/Aids search for a vaccine. The Washington Post described Fauci as someone with a reputation of being a skilled public health expert while battling AIDS in the 1980s. The battle against AIDS has proven to be a total failure with no vaccine ever found to be effective. To this day, Fauci claims that progress in vaccination therapy holds promise for an HIV/AIDS vaccine. All attempts to find an HIV/Aids vaccine have failed. The latest effort, funded by the NIAID (Fauci's employer) and the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation to the tune of \$100 million, also failed.

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It is also Dr. Fauci, who gets to decide what therapeutics we should use for treatment. It was in research done by the National Institutes of Health, where Dr. Fauci is the director, that Chloroquine was found to be an effective inhibitor of the coronavirus in 2015. It was during the SARS outbreak (SARS-CoV) that Chloroquine was found to be an effective agent, stopping SARS CoV completely. The coronavirus now ravaging our nation has a genome designated as SARS CoV-2 and shared almost 80% of the SARS genome. Both have been shown to use the same host cell receptor, which allows the virus to infect the host victim.

In the Virology Journal, an official National Institute of Health published an article on August 22, 2005, that stated that "*Chloroquine is a potent inhibitor of SAR coronavirus infection and spread*". It was also shown to be effective before or after exposure. Hydroxychloroquine, a milder form of Chloroquine, has been in use since 1952 with manageable side effects. It has been used to not only treat current cases but also to prevent future cases. It functions both as a vaccine and a cure if taken early enough. This shows that the NIH, of which Dr. Fauci was director, knew as far back as 2005 that Chloroquine was effective against the coronavirus. It was also Dr. Fauci who sent \$3.7 million to the Lab in Wuhan to study the weaponization of the coronavirus that had been outlawed in U.S. research laboratories because of the inherent dangers.

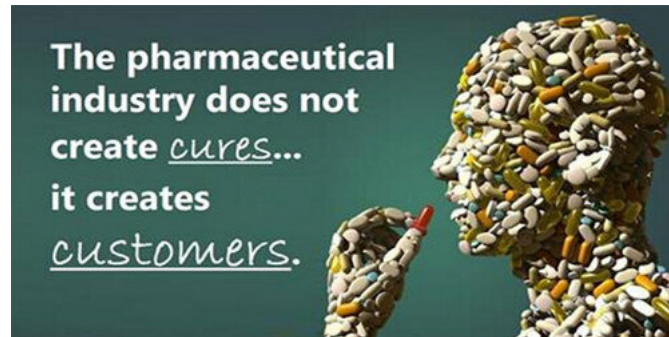
The question then becomes, that if Dr. Fauci knew since 2005, this was an effective treatment, why hasn't it been used on a nationwide basis. Could it be that the HCQ-ZPack treatment only costs about \$20 per treatment that can be scaled nationally, which alternative treatments cost up to \$20,000 and makes Big Pharma considerable profit? Rather than use the low cost and nationally available HCQ, Fauci has shown to a propensity to push for the implementation of the treatment using Remdesivir, designed to be the answer to Ebola and never gaining FDA approval. Fauci is fast-tracking Remdesivir, a therapy that has never been approved and whose cost is \$1000 per dose. The success rate is about 50%. Fauci is ignoring the known fact that HCQ is 90% effective when administered correctly.

Remdesivir is a product of Gilead Biosciences whose headquarters are at Wuxi Pharmaceuticals located in Shanghai and Suzhou and is owned by none other than George Soros. Gilead has also endorsed the drug purchasing group UNITAID w fast-growing outgrowth of the UN Millennium Global Compact. Donors to the Global Compact is George Soros, the World Health Organization, the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, and the Clinton Health Access Initiative. Dr, Fauci also has a direct connection to the Clinton Health Initiative. Dr. Fauci

looks to be in line for a profitable windfall if a COVID-19 vaccine is developed, and should be removed from the coronavirus task force for conflict of interest.

Through the NIAID, Dr. Fauci is cosponsoring with the Gates Foundation the project to procure a vaccine through Moderna, which Fauci is touting to go into clinical trials in April. Notable is that the Moderna Vaccine candidate mRNA-1273 was rolled out in weeks, not months or years, and were sent to the NIH run by Fauci for testing.

Fauci and the Big Pharma lobbyists claim that without controlled trials, Chloroquine can not be used “*off label*” and refuse to look at the evidence that HCQ works as both a cure and a preventative. The Association of American Physicians and Surgeons wrote a letter to Gov. Doug Ducey (D) about the efficacy of the HCQ protocol declaring that the country can’t wait for a large body of clinical trials to draw the conclusion that HCQ works.



Dr. Didier Raoult has great success using HCQ to treat victims of SARS CoV2. It has been proven the HCQ, along with azithromycin and zinc, was a cure for 79 of 80 patients. A VA study claimed that HCQ was ineffective, until it was shown that the HCQ was administered to those in their 80’s and only as a last resort. It was not used in combination with the azithromycin (Z-Pack) or zinc, lowering the effectiveness. It has clearly been shown that the HCQ-Zpack-Zinc combination is highly effective when given at the earliest showing of symptoms. It doesn’t make sense to withhold treatment until it is too late for the procedure to be of any benefit.

Even with all these facts being known, the governors of New York, Nevada, and Michigan all banned the use of this treatment.

The rebel forces in America's latest culture war — the so-called anti-vaxxers — are often described as middle- and upper-class women who breast-feed their children, shop at Whole Foods, endlessly scour the web for vaccine-related conversation, and believe that their thinking supersedes that of doctors. Typically their families earn more than \$75,000 a year.

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That's based on findings from various studies, including the National Immunization Surveys conducted by the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases.

It's also echoed by doctors, sociologists, and anthropologists who follow the vaccination debate raging around the country at a time when measles outbreaks have hit several states, including New Jersey, New York, California, and Michigan.

As of last week, 465 measles cases had been reported this year, the most since 667 cases in 2014, according to the Associated Press. And 140 cases of mumps have been recorded at Temple University this year as well.

Reports indicate many of the infected weren't vaccinated. The CDC says that the percentage of children who are unvaccinated has quadrupled since 2001. About 25 percent of parents are delaying vaccinations or allowing only certain vaccines to be used "cafeteria style," said Jennifer Reich, sociologist at the University of Colorado and author of the book *Calling the Shots: Why Parents Reject Vaccines*.

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## **USPS Defies Orders To Close Denver Sorting Facility That Handles Mail For All Of Colorado**

**DENVER (CBS4/AP)** – A U.S. Postal Service facility in Denver is defying orders to shut down after the city and county health department reported multiple COVID-19 cases among employees. The massive sorting facility at 53rd and Quebec Street handles mail for all of Colorado and Wyoming.

The 840,000-square-foot mail facility, the fourth largest in the United States, has about 2,000 workers.

Officials with the Denver Department of Public Health & Environment (DDPHE) said they issued the closure order as a last resort — because USPS officials are not cooperating with their investigation.

“...the USPS not only failed to provide the necessary information, but they have not allowed inspections to support complete outbreak investigations,” DDPHE officials stated.

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“It certainly is not our intent to halt the delivery of mail or shut down an essential federal facility,” officials stated. “This was a measure of last resort, and the only remaining tool we have to get the facility management’s attention and secure public health compliance during a pandemic.”

USPS spokesman David Rupert said there is no current outbreak there and the last time a worker there was confirmed to have COVID-19 was May 2.

USPS officials also argue the facility provides an essential service.

“The Postal Service is an entity of the Federal Government, and the provision of postal services to the American people is designated as an essential function under federal law during times of emergency,” USPS officials stated.

“This closure... has the potential to impact stimulus checks, prescription medications, personal correspondence, and vital goods delivered to the more than 6.5 million customers who live in Colorado and Wyoming.”

In its order, Denver officials said the facility should remain closed until the facility can be sanitized and safety procedures, including employee being checked for symptoms and being required to wear face coverings, are followed. They also want the Postal Service to report any new coronavirus cases within 24 hours.

The Postal Service says it is meeting all CDC and federal guidelines for COVID-19.
